Anti-Pak Propaganda of TTPs Umer Media and Reality

Presently, media especially the social media, is being used as a weapon for creating certain mindsets. Terrorists try to assert their superiority over government, security agencies and general public by resorting to propaganda. Hostile intelligence agencies provide financial, technical and administrative support to these terrorists in spreading their propaganda. A clear example is recent propaganda by TTPs Umar Media.

After the withdrawal of foreign troops from Afghanistan, intelligence agencies have turned their attention to propaganda over media specifically social media and intensified financial, technical and administrative support of propaganda platforms such as Umar Media

Some important facts about Umar Media that expose its involvement and supervision by enemy intelligence agencies, are as follows:

- More than 80% followers of Umar media platforms are from enemy countries, which is being used by enemy intelligence agencies to induce specific mindset among people of Pakistan. This trend has further increased with Modi government in India, which is spreading religious and linguistic extremism in India as well.
- The technical and administrative affairs of Umar Media have been handed over by hostile intelligence agencies to such private institutions; access and tracking of which is difficult by Pakistan's Government and intelligence agencies. An example of this is hosting of Umar Media website on a server located in US.
- Social media platforms like Twitter, Facebook and Telegram also support terrorist-linked platforms like Umar Media.

People of Pakistan should not believe such rumors, which are actually failed attempts to create unrest in Pakistan. Such content should always be ignored and treated as propaganda and save one's self from propagating it unknowingly.
