Anti-Pakistan Nexus of TTP and Afghan Taliban Exposed TTP's Traditional Hypocrisy, Fake Claims and Real Facts

In an interview given to a digital broadcast organization recently, TTP Khawarij Leader Noor Wali admitted the meetings with top leadership of Afghan Taliban and continuous facilitation of the Afghan Taliban for terrorist activities against Pakistan. After publication of the report, due to reprimand and increasing pressure from the Afghan Taliban, hypocritical group of the TTP is forced to make fake statements, showing its traditional hypocrisy, while the actual facts in this context are as follows:

- ▲ In recent past, even last month, TTP Khawarij leadership had several meetings with the Afghan Taliban, why are the Khawarij afraid to admit these meetings and the real motives.
- ▲ TTP is under pressure due to Pakistan's clear policy on Afghanistan, as Pakistan has made it clear to Afghanistan that the only issue between the two countries is presence of TTP on Afghan soil and its anti-Pakistan activities. Difficulties of the Afghan government have increased in the last few months and if they do not take concrete steps against the TTP, they may lose Pakistan's support.
- ▲ After all, TTP has admitted to being under the influence of Afghan Taliban, which is a negation of their concept of self-imposed jihad, because if the jihad ended with the American withdrawal, then how did the new concept of jihad against Pakistan emerge. Whether the TTP is alone or with the Afghan Taliban, this ideological difference creates ambiguity, which is also evident from the UN report.
- ▲ Western countries and the independent media have also signaled continued cooperation between the two, challenging the basic ideology of jihad while their self-styled scholars continue to mis-interpret jihad.
- ▲ No matter who met when, nothing is hidden from Pakistan. Afghanistan should understand that it is Pakistan not America and knows who is who. To foster mutual cooperation, Afghanistan must find a permanent solution to the TTP issue.
- ▲ Situation has become dire for TTP. If they come to Pakistan, death is inevitable, as the operations of the security forces have intensified and their future in Afghanistan is bleak as the business of war in Afghanistan is over. The only realistic option for Afghan Taliban is to accept Pakistan's demands and take concrete steps against TTP.

Hypocritical narrative is a proof of TTP leadership's cowardice, Days of Khawarij are numbered and InshaAllah, their fate is not far because the Pakistani nation and security agencies are more united and optimistic than ever to eliminate these Khawarij.
